The Play Selection Committee needs to read the official Acting Edition of the production you are proposing. No photocopies, digital copies, or different versions of the same play will be accepted. Submit any supporting materials when you submit scripts.

On the online submission form, you will need to check the most appropriate box before you submit your proposal.

I (or an associate) will deliver two (2) Acting Editions of my proposed play, either through the mail or in person to Sean Walbeck at the Bellingham Theatre Guild between 4:00 and 6:00 pm on December 1, 2019. At the end of the review process, my scripts will be returned to me.

The play I am proposing is available only through perusal at the Publisher's website. I will confirm with the Committee Chair which precise edition of this play I am proposing, so the Play Selection Committee can procure the correct script.
